GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1. All inquiries or clarifications to the RFB may be directed, by email only, to pgregoire@omahameca.com. No phone inquiries will be accepted. Final questions must be submitted no later than 11:00 am, Thursday, September 13, 2018.
2. Bids must be in the office of MECA, 455 North 10th Street, Omaha, NE 68102 by the closing date and time indicated above.
3. Bids must be delivered in a sealed envelope and marked: Attn: Patti Gregoire, Bid on T12 Floor Scrubber .
4. MECA reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in their entirety.
5. MECA reserves the right to accept or reject any part of a bid unless otherwise indicated by bidder.
6. Bidder must be willing to execute a MECA Purchase Agreement. A copy of the Agreement is available upon request.
7. Warranty terms and length of warranty must be included. Please specify who is responsible for the warranty (manufacturer or bidder).
8. Delivery and shipping charges must be included as a separate line item.
9. Sales tax must be included as a separate line item. Bidder must supply MECA with its Nebraska Sales Tax Permit Number below. If the Bidder does not have a sales tax permit in the State of Nebraska, please indicate below. As a Vendor of CHIHCO, any sales tax collected must be reported to the State of Nebraska on a monthly basis. A Convention Center Facility Financing Assistance Act Sales and Use Tax Information Form must be completed and filed on or before the 20th day of the month following the month of sale. Forms are available by contacting MECA's Finance Department.

PROJECT DETAILS: This bid is for the purchase of a Tennant Model T12 36 volt Riding Scrubber with Hydrolink battery watering system and high-capacity batteries. Equivalent manufacturer's/models may be considered as an Alternate. Alternates must meet or exceed specifications listed below. Bidder must provide a fully detailed spec sheet if proposing an alternate. Failure to provide a spec sheet will disqualify a Bidder's proposal. The machine manufacturer must have local Factory-Direct Service. All equipment must be new with no used or refurbished parts. This bid includes, but is not limited to ordering, receiving, unloading on MECA's dock, assembly, testing, initial training and any other items necessary for a full and complete order (such as a battery charger and one set of disk brushes, installed). Bidder must fully disclose all pricing necessary for a full and complete order. We are also requesting the haul away and proper disposal of two scrubbers (Tennant 7100 & 7300) as well as a 6100 riding vacuum. Sales tax must be included in the total. Pricing must remain valid for 90 days.

TRAINING: The successful bidder will be responsible for providing an initial opening and maintenance training session for selected MECA employees on the operation and general maintenance of the scrubber. The training shall be performed onsite and will be scheduled at a mutually agreed upon date and time. The successful bidder must submit one electronic and one hard copy of the manufacturer's operating procedures, service, and parts manual. Also included must be a list of procedures required to maintain the equipment and activities/procedures to be avoided in order to prolong the life of the equipment and maintain the warranty.

PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT: Bidders are to provide pricing for a five-year preventative maintenance agreement. At a minimum, the service must include two (2) annual on-site visits to inspect equipment and perform general maintenance of the equipment. All parts and labor costs must be included in the maintenance price, including but not limited to the replacement of brushes and squeegees. Bidders must include a sample of the maintenance agreement with the bid.
